A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO RESERVED RESIDENTIAL PARKING IN PUBLIC BEACH ACCESS PARKING AREAS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI:

- SECTION 1. Section 10.48.250, Maui County Code, is amended by amending subsection A to read as follows:
 - "A. All public beach access parking areas must reserve at least half of the designated parking stalls for Maui County residents. As used in this section, "Maui County resident" means a person who has a current, valid State of Hawaii identification or driver's license containing a County of Maui address. No person [shall] can park any vehicle in any public beach access parking area unless using the beach for recreational purposes.

As used in this section, "recreational purposes" means hunting, fishing, swimming, boating, picnicking, hiking, nature study, water skiing, and viewing or enjoying historical, archeological, scenic, or scientific sites."

- SECTION 2. Section 10.48.250, Maui County Code, is amended by amending subsection B to read as follows:
 - "B. All public beach access parking areas [shall] <u>must</u> be posted with signs warning that vehicles will be towed away if the operators are using the parking area for other than beach recreational purposes[.], or if non-residents are parked in designated stalls reserved for Maui County residents."
- SECTION 3. Material to be repealed is bracketed. New material is underscored. In printing this bill, the County Clerk need not include the brackets, the bracketed material, or the underscoring.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance takes effect upon its approval.
