Please see proposal below, I can provide lots more info and talking points on advantage to community and County for this project as budget process continues. We will advocate for funding on appropriate days for the public to testify, please let us know when!

\$375K - Funds to be used for design, engineering, permitting, construction, lighting (possibly solar), fencing, gates and operational funds.

Since this is a preliminary estimate based on current installation at Wells Park there may be some unforeseen costs and we may need to request some additional funding for 2023 budget.

Goal is to implement pay to park and use funds to offset operational costs, cost of implementation of this lot and to fund the implementation of the Baldwin Beach Masterplan.

To save money we plan to reuse Wells St temporary lot materials which is 90 stalls and designed to be ADA compliant. (cost for the purchase of the Supa-Trac product was \$285K)
