A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 2.08 MAUI COUNTY CODE, TO ESTABLISH A DEPUTY DIRECTOR OF COUNCIL SERVICES AND REVISING PAY RANGES FOR COUNCIL SERVICES STAFF

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI:

SECTION 1. Section 2.08.010, Maui County Code, is amended to read as follows:

- **"2.08.010 Office of council services.** A. There is established an office of council services [pursuant to] in accordance with section 3-7 of the charter. The council may provide for a director, deputy director, and necessary staff.
- B. The term of employment for the director, <u>deputy</u> <u>director</u>, and staff [shall coincide] <u>coincides</u> with the term of office of the council, unless sooner terminated for cause by vote of six or more members of the council."

SECTION 2. Section 2.08.020, Maui County Code, is amended to read as follows:

**"2.08.020 Director** and deputy director of council services. There [shall] may be a director and deputy director of council services. The council [shall have] has the power to appoint and remove the director[.] and deputy director."

SECTION 3. Section 2.08.060, Maui County Code, is amended to read as follows:

**"2.08.060 Salaries.** A. The following pay plan is established:

assistant [shall] <u>must</u> be set by the council member supervising the position. The pay of each council aide [shall] <u>must</u> be set by the council chair, within the range established by this section.

Compensation [shall] <u>must</u> not exceed appropriations[,] and [shall be] <u>is</u> subject to the general authority of the council chair, as chief administrative officer of the legislative branch, to adopt appropriate

personnel policies (including policies regarding employee benefits, personnel leaves, and furloughs) unless otherwise required by the council."

SECTION 4. Material to be repealed is bracketed. New material is

brackets, the bracketed material, or the underscoring.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance takes effect upon its approval.

SECTION 1. Section 2.08.010, Maui County Code, is amended to read as follows:
