BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI:

SECTION 1. Section 20.08.031, Maui County Code, is amended to read

as follows:

"20.08.031 Limited exclusions. Sections 20.08.040 through 20.08.160 regarding permit applications and requirements [shall] <u>do</u> not apply to the following[,]; however all other provisions of this chapter, including the provision of minimum bmps as required by section 20.08.035, [shall] remain applicable to all work performed, and the following [shall] <u>exclusions do</u> not affect the applicability of section 20.08.040.C relating to cut or fill activity in special management areas:

A. Subsurface excavations and backfill for buildings and other structures authorized by a valid building permit issued by the land use and codes administration or excavations and backfill for cesspools and septic tanks authorized by the state department of health. This [exception shall] <u>exclusion does</u> not affect the applicability of this chapter to the placing of fill materials obtained from the excavations on other premises[;].

B. Excavation, fill, or stockpiling [which] <u>that</u> does not alter the general drainage pattern with respect to abutting properties and [which] <u>that</u> does not exceed one hundred cubic yards of material on any one site and does not exceed four feet in vertical height at its highest point; [provided] <u>except</u> that the slope face may not be steeper in slope and be located a minimum distance from neighboring properties, as enumerated in sections 20.08.170 through 20.08.210[;].

C. Grubbing [which] <u>that</u> does not alter the general drainage pattern with respect to abutting properties and does not exceed one acre[;].

D. Trenching for underground utilities, involving trenches less than two feet deep and less than fifty cubic yards, provided [when] the trenches are backfilled[,] and the surface restored to its pre-existing grade and ground cover[.], except that this exclusion does not apply in an area determined by the County archaeologist as likely to involve a burial site or historic property, as defined by Hawaii Revised Statutes chapter 6E."

SECTION 2. Material to be repealed is bracketed. New material is underscored. In printing this bill, the County Clerk need not include the brackets, the bracketed material, or the underscoring.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance takes effect November 1, 2021.

I hope this memorandum finds you well and am writing in response to your request for legal services regarding the proposed bill to amend the categorical exclusions included in Chapter 20.08.031, Maui County Code ("MCC"). In response to your request for legal services, I offer the following comments. Also attached, please find a signed clean copy of the bill with revisions, as well as the red-lined document for reference. Thank you for the opportunity to work on this.

After reviewing the bill submitted to our office, and consistent with the initial language considered by the Agriculture and Public Trust Committee at its May 18, 2021 meeting, our office recommends repealing Subsection 20.08.031(D), MCC ("subsection D"). The repeal of subsection D will result in departmental review and oversight of projects involving trenching for underground utilities that exceed one hundred cubic yards of material on any one site and exceed four feet in vertical height at the highest point. Please note, "trenching" has been added to Subsection 20.08.031(B), MCC, for clarity.
