GAINESVILLE SAFE CAMP: PROJECT OVERVIEW

DIGNITY VILLAGE

- Unmanaged, 5 year history
- Grew from 10 people to 300
- No housing data, no housing placement
- \$37,000 monthly EMS response

GRACE SAFE CAMP

- Housing-focused
- Low-barrier, with focus on health and safety
- Coordination with CoC, other providers
- No new entries, roster dropped from 90 to 2 in 14 months
