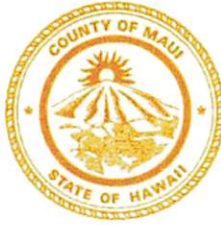

Section 3201 of the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021, Pub. L. No. 117-2 (March 11, 2021) established the Emergency Rental Assistance Program (ERA2). The State of Hawai'i has received an allocation of \$95,184,413.30 from the U.S. Department of the Treasury.

The State of Hawai'i's will provide the County of Maui a \$710,000 sub-award from the ERA2 as appropriated in Act 57(21) to contract for services as permissible by Act 57(21) and the guidance published by the United States Treasury for Emergency Rental Assistance.

Dear Mayor Victorino:

On March 11, 2021, the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) was signed into law by the President. Section 9901 of ARPA amended Title VI of the Social Security Act to add section 602, which established the Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund (CSFRF). The CSFRF is intended to provide support to State governments in responding to the impact of COVID-19. The State of Hawai'i received an allocation of \$1,641,602,609.60 from the U.S. Department of the Treasury to be used for purposes of the CSFRF.

The State of Hawai'i will provide the County of Maui a \$100,000 sub-award from the CSFRF as appropriated in Act 57 (21) to contract for services as permissible by Act 57 (21) and the guidance published by the United States Treasury to assist households that do not qualify under American Rescue Plan Act of 2021, Section 3201, Emergency Rental Assistance, Housing Stability Services funds.
