A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR
OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI TO ENTER INTO AN
INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH THE
DEPARTMENT OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL, STATE OF HAWAII

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI:

SECTION 1. Purpose. The Department of the Attorney General, State of Hawaii ("Agency"), through the Crime Prevention and Justice Assistance Division, has awarded a STOP Violence Against Women Formula Grant to the Department of the Prosecuting Attorney, County of Maui, attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as Exhibit "1", in the amount of EIGHTY-TWO THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED FIFTY NINE DOLLARS (\$82,459). The County of Maui is required to provide matching funds in the amount of TWENTY-SEVEN THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED EIGHTY-SEVEN DOLLARS (\$27,487), which was provided in the Fiscal Year 2022 Budget for the Department of the Prosecuting Attorney.

Section 2.20.020, Maui County Code, provides that, unless authorized by ordinance, the Mayor shall not enter into any intergovernmental agreement or any amendment thereto which places a financial obligation upon the county or any department or agency thereof.

SECTION 2. Council authorization. Pursuant to Section 2.20.020, Maui County Code, the Council of the County of Maui hereby authorizes the Mayor to execute the Agreement, all other necessary documents relating to the Agreement, and any amendments thereto.

SECTION 3. Effective date. This ordinance shall take effect upon its approval. All action heretofore taken, not inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance, is hereby ratified, approved and affirmed.

We are pleased to award the Maui County Department of the Prosecuting Attorney the following funding amount from the FY 2020 STOP Violence Against Women Formula Grant:

The STOP grant's allocation for law enforcement is distributed through a formula plan in which each county police department receives a base amount, with the balance of the allocation divided based upon county population. Through this formula distribution, law enforcement agencies are able to develop long-term plans for the funds, leverage and coordinate the STOP funds with local resources, and have greater flexibility for use of funds as needs change.

To receive the award, **please submit an application by May 14, 2021.** The proposed project must meet the following requirements: 1) address one or more of the 20 authorized purpose areas established by the Office on Violence Against Women; 2) address one or more of the funding priority areas outlined in the state's VAWA Implementation Plan; 3) provide cash or in-kind match of 25% of the project's budget; and 4) complete a Certificate of Collaboration indicating consultation with local victim services providers in the course of developing the application.
