 - b. Is there a deadline for making the funding determinations?
- 3. Please provide information on the plans for unexpended CARES Act funding. For example, the State has indicated they intend to place any unexpended funds into Unemployment Insurance.

- 4. What is the deadline for expending the H.E.L.P. funds? Is there a plan if the funds are not entirely spent by December 15, 2020?
- 5. When will the second round of CARES Act funding be announced?
