A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING  
THE FISCAL YEAR 2022 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI  
AS IT PERTAINS TO APPENDIX A, PART I,  
GRANTS AND RESTRICTED USE REVENUES – SCHEDULE OF GRANTS AND  
RESTRICTED USE REVENUES BY DEPARTMENTS AND PROGRAMS,  
DEPARTMENT OF FIRE AND PUBLIC SAFETY  
(STATE OF HAWAII MAKENA LIFEGUARD SERVICES)

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 5217, Bill No. 46 (2021), Draft 1, as amended, "Fiscal Year 2022 Budget", Appendix A, Part I, Grants and Restricted Use Revenues – Schedule of Grants and Restricted Use Revenues by Departments and Programs for Fiscal Year 2022, is hereby amended as it pertains to the Department of Fire and Public Safety, by adding a new grant entitled "State of Hawaii Makena Lifeguard Services" in the amount of \$1,446,936 and by adding 10.5 equivalent personnel, to read as follows:

h. Private Donations	30,000
i. State of Hawaii Department of Transportation Highway Safety Grants	50,000
j. United States Department of Homeland Security (DHS) Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Assistance to Firefighters Fire Prevention and Safety Grants	75,000
k. United States Department of Homeland Security (DHS) Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Assistance to Firefighters Grant (AFG) Program - Operations and Safety Program	300,000
