Legislation: Resolution relating to the Rules of the Council.

- Proposer: Michael J. Molina, Chair Government Relations, Ethics, and Transparency Committee
- Description: Proposed revision will add Rule 30 to the Rules of the Council that limits the number of times a member can use Rule 7G of the Rules of the Council.
 - a. Motion: Move to amend the proposed resolution to create Rule 30, to read as follows:
 - a. "Each member shall be permitted the use of Rule 7G, Referral to committees of the Rules of the Council to no more than once per regular Council meeting."

Reasons:

- 1. My proposed amendments to the Council Rules are offered to help reduce the length of Council meetings.
- 2. This proposed new Rule 30 is submitted in the same light.
- 3. Since the proposed amendment to Rule 7G did not pass, I want to try to limit the use of Council meetings for Committee business.
- 4. Therefore, I would ask that we limit the number of items that can be waived for referral to committee to one per member per council meeting.
- 5. There have been instances where members have requested numerous items be heard on the Council floor.
- 6. This extends our meetings and defeats the purpose for having council committees to adequately deliberate an item.
