Your Government Relations, Ethics, and Transparency Committee, having met on September 28, 2021, makes reference to County Communication 21-42, from Council Chair Alice L. Lee, relating to nominations to boards, committees, and commissions.

By correspondence dated and received on September 14, 2021, the Mayor transmitted a proposed resolution, entitled "RELATING TO THE APPOINTMENT OF ELAINE SLAVINSKY TO THE COUNCIL ON AGING," with a completed application for the nominee.

The purpose of the proposed resolution is to approve or disapprove the Mayor's nomination of Elaine Slavinsky to the Council on Aging, for a term expiring on March 31, 2023, to fill a vacancy due to the resignation of Katherine Smith.

Your Committee further notes specific provisions for the Council on Aging are located in Sections 2.34.020, 2.34.030, and 2.40.010, Maui County Code.

The Council must approve or disapprove the nomination by November 13, 2021, or the nomination will be deemed approved.
