A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 2.82.050, MAUI COUNTY CODE, RELATING TO GREENPRINT

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI:

SECTION 1. Section 2.82.050, Maui County Code, is amended to read as follows:

"2.82.050 Greenprint. [Utilizing] <u>Using</u> public outreach, the general plan, and other community and documentary resources, including land conservation organizations, a comprehensive conservation plan, also known as a greenprint, [shall] <u>must</u> be created [which] <u>that</u> includes a geographic information systems map. The greenprint [shall] <u>will</u> guide land acquisition by the County for open space, natural resources, cultural resources, and scenic views preservation purposes, and help to identify lands suitable for voluntary private-sector conservation. [The] <u>A proposed</u> greenprint [shall] <u>must</u> be adopted by the committee and submitted to the council by [January 1, 2021.] <u>December 31, 2022.</u> The committee [shall] <u>must</u> oversee the review and update of the [Countywide] greenprint, which [shall] <u>must</u> be submitted to the council every five years [thereafter].

SECTION 2. Material to be repealed is bracketed. New material is underscored. In printing this bill, the County Clerk need not include the brackets, the bracketed material, or the underscoring.

SECTION 3. This ordinance takes effect on approval.
