PROBLEM STATEMENT

MAUI POLICE DEPARTMENT TRAFFIC DATA

Grant No: TR22-M-04

Identify the traffic safety related problem or deficiency that the proposed grant is intended to correct.

According to a major recommendation of Hawaii's Traffic Records Assessment in September 2011 (under 2-A: Crash Data Component), the Hawaii Traffic Records Coordinating Committee (TRCC) should "make solving the crash timeliness problem as the number one traffic records priority for the State." The assessment team urged that "Hawaii devote the bulk of its Section 408 grant funds to electronic field data collection and electronic submission until the problems are solved." As a result, the HTRCC has deemed projects relating to electronic transfer of crash records and electronic Motor Vehicle Accident Reports (MVAR) as a top priority.

We have implemented a File Transfer Protocol (FTP) with our Motor Vehicle Accident Reports and Hawaii Department of Transportation. It's currently a manual process; however, we are working on making this automated. MPD has recently changed their entire CADS/RMS systems. However, we continue to work with state DOT and the SHACA project. The current problem is we can not obtain real time or current crash data from DOT as we do not provide them with the information daily. The problem is without crash data it can be difficult to identify causes of crashes at certain locations and identify the need for specific enforcement. Furthermore, the issuance of citations by patrol

sector is still paper. This is very time consuming and inaccuracies are inevitable as the citations must be manually entered on the judicary side. With the implementation of TBL for traffic officers and parking enforcement, we have been able to significantly reduce the amount of time it takes from citation issuance to judiciary acceptance. We would like to increase the amount of users of TBL and help in reducing errors and inaccuracies with judiciary.

GRANT GOALS MAUI POLICE DEPARTMENT TRAFFIC DATA Grant No: TR22-M-04

Goals serve as the foundation upon which the grant is built. Goals are what you hope to accomplish by implementing a traffic safety grant and represent an end result. The goal of this grant is to:

1. Decrease the average time it takes from crash occurrence to entry into HDOT database from 211 days in 2020 to 158 days by September 30, 2022.

Continue with the electronic issuance of traffic citations to reduce the errors and timiliness issues that result in citations being dismissed by district courts. Currently MPD using e-citations program has a 90% acceptance rate from Judiciary. The goal is to reduce officer error and increase acceptance rate to closer to 95% with zero officer errors and timiliness issues.
 MPD will also incorporate TBL analytics data with HIGLS data to assist in determining best locations to deploy resources for enforcement by September 30, 2022;

The grant activities that will be conducted to achieve the grant goals are: 1. Contract with Thin Blue Line Reporting for 1 year to conduct the eCitation pilot program.

2. Meet with the Department of Motor Vehicles and Thin Blue Line Reporting at least 3 times to address printing and legibility concerns related to Hawaii motor vehicle registrations.

3. Participate in at least 4 Traffic Records Coordinating Committee meetings.

4. Participate in at least 4 eCitation Subcommittee meetings.

5. Send 1 person to the 2022 International Forum on Traffic Records.

6. Meet with HDOT at least 1 time to work on implementation of HIGLS between MPD and the State of Hawaii Advanced Crash Analysis (SHACA) system.

The Maui Police Department will evaluate the progress of this project by analyzing the number of crash data reports that are submitted electronically to the DOT and compare this to the baseline data. The progress of these goals/objectives will be documented in the quarterly reports to the Highway Safety Office.

The Maui Police Department will evaluate the progress of the e-Citation pilot program by evaluating the equipment by keeping track of and providing the following information.

1. How much time is saved by issuing an electronic citation vs. writing one. Time saved when issuing a traffic infraction and traffic crime upon one violator/data transfer.

2. How safety is improved for the officers utilizing this equipment. Daytime vs. nighttime.

3. How accurate is the information that is being sent to Judiciary/Traffic Violations Bureau. Including the amount of errors being added or reduced by using this technology. (illegible, missing data, missed deadlines)

In addition, MPD will evaluate the progress of the grant activities and include the progress in the quarterly reports to the Highway Safety Office.

•Executive Order 12898, Federal Actions to Address Environmental Justice in Minority Populations and Low-Income Populations (prevents discrimination against minority populations by discouraging programs, policies, and activities with disproportionately high and adverse human health or environmental effects on minority and low-income populations); and

•Executive Order 13166, Improving Access to Services for Persons with Limited English Proficiency (guards against Title VI national origin discrimination/discrimination because of limited English proficiency (LEP) by ensuring that funding recipients take reasonable steps to ensure that LEP persons have meaningful access to programs (70 FR 74087-74100). The State highway safety agency—

•Will take all measures necessary to ensure that no person in the United States shall, on the grounds of race, color, national origin, disability, sex, age, limited English proficiency, or membership in any other class protected by Federal Nondiscrimination Authorities, be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be otherwise subjected to discrimination under any of its programs or activities, so long as any portion of the program is Federally-assisted;

•Will administer the program in a manner that reasonably ensures that any of its subrecipients, contractors, subcontractors, and consultants receiving Federal financial assistance under this program will comply with all requirements of the Non-Discrimination Authorities identified in this Assurance;

•Agrees to comply (and require its subrecipients, contractors, subcontractors, and consultants to comply) with all applicable provisions of law or regulation governing US DOT's or NHTSA's access to records, accounts, documents, information, facilities, and staff, and to cooperate and comply with any program or compliance reviews, and/or complaint investigations conducted by US DOT or NHTSA under any Federal Nondiscrimination Authority;

•Acknowledges that the United States has a right to seek judicial enforcement with regard to any matter arising under these Non-Discrimination Authorities and this Assurance:

•Agrees to insert in all contracts and funding agreements with other State or private entities the following clause:

"During the performance of this contract/funding agreement, the contractor/funding recipient agrees—

a. To comply with all Federal nondiscrimination laws and regulations, as may be amended from time to time;

b.Not to participate directly or indirectly in the discrimination prohibited by any Federal nondiscrimination law or regulation, as set forth in appendix B of 49 CFR part 21 and herein;

c. To permit access to its books, records, accounts, other sources of information, and its facilities as required by the State highway safety office, US DOT or NHTSA;

d. That, in event a contractor/funding recipient fails to comply with any nondiscrimination provisions in this contract/funding agreement, the State highway safety agency will have the right to impose such contract/agreement sanctions as it or NHTSA determine are appropriate, including but not limited to withholding payments to the contractor/funding recipient under the contract/agreement until the contractor/funding recipient complies; and/or cancelling, terminating, or suspending a contract or funding agreement, in whole or in part; and

e. To insert this clause, including paragraphs (a) through (e), in every subcontract and subagreement and in every solicitation for a subcontract or sub-agreement, that receives Federal funds under this program.

POLITICAL ACTIVITY (HATCH ACT)

The APPLICANT will comply with provisions of the Hatch Act (5 U.S.C. 1501-1508), which limits the political activities of employees whose principal employment activities are funded in whole or in part with Federal funds.

CERTIFICATION REGARDING FEDERAL LOBBYING

Certification for Contracts, Grants, Loans, and Cooperative Agreements. The undersigned certifies, to the best of his or her knowledge and belief, that:

1. This certification is a material representation of fact upon which reliance was placed when this transaction was made or entered into. Submission of this certification is a prerequisite for making or entering into this transaction imposed by section 1352, title 31, U.S. Code. Any person who fails to file the required certification shall be subject to a civil penalty of not less than \$10,000 and not more than \$100,000 for each such failure.

RESTRICTION ON STATE LOBBYING

None of the funds under this program will be used for any activity specifically designed to urge or influence a State or local legislator to favor or oppose the adoption of any specific legislative proposal pending before any State or local legislative body. Such activities include both direct and indirect (e.g., "grassroots") lobbying activities, with one exception. This does not preclude a State official whose salary is supported with NHTSA funds from engaging in direct communications with State or local legislative officials, in accordance with customary State practice, even if such communications urge legislative officials to favor or oppose the adoption of a specific pending legislative proposal.

3. The prospective lower tier participant shall provide immediate written notice to the person to which this proposal is submitted if at any time the prospective lower tier participant learns that its certification was erroneous when submitted or has become erroneous by reason of changed circumstances.

4. The terms covered transaction, civil judgment, debarment, suspension, ineligible, participant, person, principal, and voluntarily excluded, as used in this clause, are defined in 2 CFR parts 180 and 1200.
