Chair and Members:

Your Human Concerns and Parks Committee, having met on November 4, 2021, makes reference to County Communication 21-388, from Councilmember Kelly Takaya King, relating to Commercial Ocean Recreational Activity ("CORA") permits and other commercial activity at County beach parks.

Your Committee received a computer-generated presentation from the Department of Parks and Recreation ("Department").

The presentation provided the following information:

- CORA permits are issued annually and do not exceed 12 months.
- Permits are processed in accordance with Section 102-10 of the County of Maui Administrative Rules.
- There are 11 beach parks on Maui Island where CORA activities are prohibited.
- All permits are subject to capacities and operating days and hours.

Your Committee discussed the rates and fees for CORA permits.

Your Committee inquired whether permittees were required to display their permits at beach parks.


