Subject: Pickleball shortage in central Maui.....we need your help.....PLEASE!

Dear Government Official,

The Wailuku area is the most densely populated area on Maui, yet we have the least amount of pickleball courts and pickleball play time!

We have only 2 shared courts in Wailuku and they are only reserved 2 nights a week (Tuesday and Thursday)???

WHY?????

We are respectfully asking for the following to bring our area up to the standards of the rest of the county:

1. New bright pickleball lines to be painted on the upper two courts and the single court at the middle section/practice wall area at War Memorial .
2. Permanent pickleball nets to be installed on the upper two courts and the middle court where there is a practice wall at War Memorial.
3. A fence be installed between the middle pickleball court and the practice wall so that pickleball games do not interfere with people using the wall for practice (there's plenty of room there for both pickleball games and a practice wall, we just need a fence to separate the two areas and keep balls from rolling into one another's areas)
4. Add Friday, Saturday and Sunday mornings as designated pickleball times from 7:30 to 10:30 AM (all 3 courts at War Memorial)
5. Place a Pickleball/Tennis sign on the fence in the parking to help new people find the courts.
6. Open the War Memorial restrooms on Fri., Sat., and Sun. mornings. We gotta go.....
7. Get funding to turn the upper 2 tennis courts at War Memorial into 6 pickleball courts to accommodate the exploding pickleball community here in Wailuku and the Baldwin High school pickleball players.
8. Have the nice man that blows leaves off the pickleball courts at War Memorial do it before 7:30 am , or after 10:30 am on Fri., Sat. and Sun. mornings.
9. Paint pickleball lines on the courts at Wells Park so the courts can be shared between pickleball and tennis players.
10. Paint pickleball lines and supply pickleball nets at the War Memorial Gym.
