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BILL 104 (2022), NOTICE TO PROPERTY OWNERS AND LESSEES WHEN AN ACCOUNT IS IN ARREARS (ADEPT-3)

The Committee is in receipt of Bill 104 (2022), entitled “A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 14.04.060, MAUI COUNTY CODE, RELATING TO NOTICE TO PROPERTY OWNERS AND LESSEES WHEN AN ACCOUNT IS IN ARREARS.” Bill 104’s purpose is to require the Department of Water Supply to provide written notification to the property owner and any lessees at least 60 days prior to the removal of a water meter.

The Committee may consider whether to recommend passage of Bill 104 (2022) on first reading, with or without revisions. The Committee may also consider the filing of Bill 104 (2022) and other related action.
