### PROHIBITING THE SALE AND RENTAL OF DISPOSABLE BODYBOARDS (CARE-34)

The Committee is in receipt of County Communication 20-526, from Councilmember Tamara Paltin, transmitting a proposed bill entitled “A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE SALE AND RENTAL OF DISPOSABLE BODYBOARDS.” The purposes of the proposed bill are to preserve the health, safety, welfare, and scenic natural beauty of the County of Maui by regulating the sale and renting of disposable bodyboards; and to encourage the use of environmentally preferred alternatives.

The Committee may discuss matters relating to the current use of disposable body boards and the impacts the proposed bill may have on Maui County. The Committee may also hear from the Office of the Mayor and the Department of Environmental Management and consider whether to recommend passage of the proposed bill on first reading, with or without revisions, the filing of County Communication 20-526, and other related action.
