### UPDATE ON CONTESTED CASE HEARINGS PENDING BEFORE THE COMMISSION ON WATER RESOURCE MANAGEMENT (WR-6(6))

Pursuant to Rule 7(B) of the Rules of the Council, the Committee may discuss with the Department of Corporation Counsel and the Department of Water Supply the following contested case hearings pending before the Commission on Water Resource Management:

1. A Na Wai Eha case relating to Surface Water Use Permit Applications (CCH-MA15-01 and CCH-MA13-02).
2. Na Wai Eha case relating to Interim Instream Flow Standards (CCH- MA06-01).
3. East Maui case relating to Interim Instream Flow Standards (CCH- MA13-01).

The Committee may receive an update on the contested cases pending before the Commission on Water Resource Management.

With reference to this agenda item, one or more executive meetings are anticipated pursuant to Section 92-5(a)(4), Hawaii Revised Statutes, to consult with legal counsel on questions and issues pertaining to the powers, duties, privileges, immunities, and liabilities of the County, the Council, and the Committee.
