## AMENDMENTS TO THE RESIDENTIAL WORKFORCE HOUSING POLICY (HHT-2)

The Committee is in receipt of the following:

- 1. County Communication 16-132, from Councilmember Stacy Crivello, relating to amendments to the Residential Workforce Housing Policy.
- 2. Correspondence dated August 8, 2016, from the Director of Housing and Human Concerns, transmitting a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 2.96, MAUI COUNTY CODE, RELATING TO RESIDENTIAL WORKFORCE HOUSING POLICY." The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend the County's Residential Workforce Housing Policy, including provisions relating to housing credits, residential workforce housing restrictions for rental units, and vacancies in residential workforce housing units.

The Committee may consider whether to recommend passage of the proposed bill on first reading, with or without revisions. The Committee may also consider the filing of County Communication 16-132 and other related action.
