The Committee is in receipt of correspondence dated August 28, 2019, from the Department of the Corporation Counsel, requesting consideration of a proposed resolution entitled "AUTHORIZING SETTLEMENT OF A CHARGE OF DISCRIMINATION FILED WITH THE HAWAII CIVIL RIGHTS COMMISSION AND FEDERAL EQUAL EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY COMMISSION ON OCTOBER 5, 2018 UNDER EQUAL EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY COMMISSION NO. 486-2018-00541." The purpose of the proposed resolution is to authorize settlement of the case.
