AMENDMENTS TO APPENDIX A, GRANTS AND RESTRICTED USE REVENUES - SCHEDULE OF GRANTS AND RESTRICTED USE REVENUES BY DEPARTMENTS AND PROGRAMS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2020 (EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY (STATE HOMELAND SECURITY GRANT (SHSG) PROGRAM)) (EDB-45(7))

The Committee is in receipt of a correspondence dated September 26, 2019, from the Budget Director, transmitting a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2020 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI AS IT PERTAINS TO APPENDIX A, PART I, GRANTS AND RESTRICTED USE REVENUES - SCHEDULE OF GRANTS AND RESTRICTED USE REVENUES BY DEPARTMENTS AND PROGRAMS, EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY (STATE HOMELAND SECURITY GRANT (SHSG) PROGRAM)." The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend the Fiscal Year 2020 Budget, by increasing the grant appropriation for the Emergency Management Agency, State Homeland Security Grant (SHSG) Program, by \$204,000. The SHSG program provides funds to prevent, deter, respond to, and recover from threats and incidents of terrorism and supports the County of Maui in leveraging funding to support National Preparedness System initiatives.

The Committee may consider whether to recommend passage of the proposed bill on first reading, with or without revisions. The Committee may also consider the filing of the correspondence and other related action.
