AMENDMENTS TO APPENDIX A, GRANTS AND RESTRICTED USE REVENUES - SCHEDULE OF GRANTS AND RESTRICTED USE REVENUES BY DEPARTMENTS AND PROGRAMS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2020 (DEPARTMENT OF POLICE (EDWARD BYRNE MEMORIAL JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANTS)) (EDB-45(8))

The Committee is in receipt of a correspondence dated November 3, 2019, from the Budget Director, transmitting a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2020 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI AS IT PERTAINS TO APPENDIX A, PART I, GRANTS AND RESTRICTED USE REVENUES - SCHEDULE OF GRANTS AND RESTRICTED USE REVENUES BY DEPARTMENTS AND PROGRAMS, DEPARTMENT OF POLICE (EDWARD BYRNE MEMORIAL JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANTS)." The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend the Fiscal Year 2020 Budget by increasing the grant appropriation for the Department of Police, Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grants, by \$94,847. The total grant funding of \$274,847 is to be used for 1) Cybercrime Unit Enhancement, \$63,980; 2) Update Drug Analysis Instrumentation, \$130,363; 3) Statewide Multi-Jurisdictional Drug Task Force (SMDTF), \$44,304; and 4) Enhance Physical Evidence Detection, \$36,200.

The Committee may consider whether to recommend passage of the proposed bill on first reading, with or without revisions. The Committee may also consider the filing of the correspondence and other related action.
