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## PROPOSED CHARTER AMENDMENTS (AFFORDABLE HOUSING FUND) (GET-10(3))

The Committee is in receipt of correspondence dated July 24, 2019, from Council Chair Kelly T. King, transmitting a proposed resolution entitled "PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO SECTION 9-20 OF THE REVISED CHARTER OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI (1983), AS AMENDED, RELATING TO THE AFFORDABLE HOUSING FUND." The purpose of the proposed resolution is to place on the next General Election ballot the question of whether Section 9-20 of the Revised Charter of the County of Maui (1983), as amended, shall be amended, effective July 1, 2021, to require an increase in the minimum required percentage of certified real property tax revenues, from two percent to three percent, be deposited into the Affordable Housing Fund, and that the mandated appropriation be extended through Fiscal Year 2031.

The Committee may consider whether to recommend passage of the proposed resolution, with or without revisions. The Committee may also consider the filing of the correspondence and other related action.
