## ACQUISITION OF LOT 6, HAIKU SUGAR EAST SUBDIVISION (EDB-86)

The Committee is in receipt of the following:

- 1. County Communication 20-270, from Council Chair Alice L. Lee, relating to the acquisition of Lot 6, Haiku Sugar East Subdivision, in accordance with Resolution 20-28.
- 2. Correspondence dated May 12, 2020, from the Department of the Corporation Counsel, transmitting a proposed resolution entitled "AUTHORIZING THE ACQUISITION OF APPROXIMATELY 48.774 ACRES IDENTIFIED AS TAX MAP KEY NO. (2) 2-7-007:005, SITUATED AT HAMAKUALOA, MAKAWAO, MAUI, HAWAII, BEING MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED AS LOT 6, HAIKU SUGAR EAST SUBDIVISION, FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$1,700,000.00." The purpose of the proposed resolution is to authorize the acquisition of approximately 48.774 acres identified as tax map key (2) 2-7-007:005, Hamakualoa, Makawao, Maui, Hawaii, being more particularly described as Lot 6, Haiku Sugar East Subdivision, for an amount not to exceed \$1,700,000.

The Committee may consider whether to recommend adoption of the proposed resolution, with or without revisions. The Committee may also consider whether to recommend the filing of County Communication 20-270 and other related action.

With reference to this agenda item, one or more executive meetings are anticipated pursuant to Section 92-5(a)(4), Hawaii Revised Statutes, to consult with legal counsel on questions and issues pertaining to the powers, duties, privileges, immunities, and liabilities of the County, the Council, and the Committee.
