AMENDMENTS TO APPENDIX A, GRANTS AND RESTRICTED USE REVENUES - SCHEDULE OF GRANTS AND RESTRICTED USE REVENUES BY DEPARTMENTS AND PROGRAMS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2022 (DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND HUMAN CONCERNS (DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT (HUD), EMERGENCY HOUSING VOUCHERS)) (BFED-54(2))

The Committee is in receipt of correspondence, dated August 16, 2021, from the Budget Director, transmitting a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2022 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI AS IT PERTAINS TO APPENDIX A, PART I, GRANTS AND RESTRICTED USE REVENUES - SCHEDULE OF GRANTS AND RESTRICTED USE REVENUES BY DEPARTMENTS AND PROGRAMS, DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND HUMAN CONCERNS, (DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT (HUD), EMERGENCY HOUSING VOUCHERS)." The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend the Fiscal Year 2022 Budget, Appendix A, Part I, Grants and Restricted Use Revenues - Schedule of Grants and Restricted Use Revenues by Departments and Programs, by increasing the grant "Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), Emergency Housing Vouchers," under the Department of Housing and Human Concerns, in the amount of \$420,336.

The Committee may consider whether to recommend passage of the proposed bill on first reading, with or without revisions. The Committee may also consider whether to recommend the filing of the correspondence and other related action.
