### NOMINATIONS TO BOARDS, COMMITTEES, AND COMMISSIONS (COUNCIL ON AGING) (GREAT-2(23))

The Committee is in receipt of correspondence dated and received on September 14, 2021, from the Mayor, transmitting a proposed resolution, entitled "RELATING TO THE APPOINTMENT OF ELAINE SLAVINSKY TO THE COUNCIL ON AGING," with a completed application for the nominee. The purpose of the proposed resolution is to approve or disapprove the Mayor's nomination of Elaine Slavinsky to the Council on Aging, for a term expiring on March 31, 2023, to fill a vacancy due to the resignation of Katherine Smith.

The Council must approve or disapprove the nomination by November 13, 2021, or the nomination will be deemed approved. The Committee may consider whether to recommend adoption of the proposed resolution, with or without revisions. The Committee may also consider other related action.
