- 1. County Communication 21-534, from Councilmember Shane M. Sinenci, transmitting a proposed resolution relating to cultural overlay districts.

Correspondence dated February 15, 2022, from the Committee Chair, transmitting a revised proposed resolution entitled "REFERRING TO THE LĀNA'I, MAUI, AND MOLOKA'I PLANNING COMMISSIONS AND THE MAUI COUNTY CULTURAL RESOURCES COMMISSION PROPOSED BILLS RELATING TO CULTURAL OVERLAY DISTRICTS." The purpose of the proposed resolution is to refer to the Planning Commissions and the Cultural Resources Commission for review and comment proposed bills entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTERS 2.28, 2.88, 19.48, 19.52, AND 20.08, MAUI COUNTY CODE, RELATING TO THE CULTURAL RESOURCES COMMISSION AND MAUI COUNTY CULTURAL OVERLAY DISTRICTS" and "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 19.50, MAUI COUNTY CODE, ESTABLISHING THE HĀNA CULTURAL OVERLAY DISTRICT."
