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### BILL 121 (2022), RELATING TO REAL PROPERTY TAX EXEMPTIONS (BFED-115)

The Committee is in receipt of Bill 121 (2022) entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 3.48.455, MAUI COUNTY CODE, RELATING TO REAL PROPERTY TAX EXEMPTIONS." Bill 121's purpose is to amend Sections 3.48.450 and 3.48.455, Maui County Code, to ensure certain taxpayers who are in a repayment plan with the County or live on a Department of Hawaiian Home Lands homestead lot are not disqualified from the home exemption based on delinquency status.

The Committee may consider whether to recommend passage of Bill 121 (2022) on first reading, with or without revisions. The Committee may also consider whether to recommend the filing of Bill 121 (2022) and other related action.
