BILL 153 (2022), RELATING TO THE ENERGY CODE (CARE-67)

The Committee is in receipt of the following:

- 1. County Communication 21-451, from Councilmember Kelly Takaya King, relating to the Hawai'i State Energy Conservation Code.
- 2. Bill 153 (2022), entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE REPEALING CHAPTER 16.16B, MAUI COUNTY CODE, AND ESTABLISHING A NEW CHAPTER 16.16C, MAUI COUNTY CODE, RELATING TO THE ENERGY CODE." Bill 153's purpose is to adopt the Hawai'i State Energy Code, with modifications specific to the County of Maui.
