URGING THE NATIVE HAWAIIAN CONVENTION TO CONVENE A WORKING GROUP TO CREATE HAWAIIAN NATIONALITY AS A PROTECTED CLASS FOR PURPOSES OF HAWAII'S ANTI-DISCRIMINATION LAWS (GREAT-12)

The Committee is in receipt of County Communication 20-355, from Presiding Officer Pro Tempore Tasha Kama, transmitting a proposed resolution entitled "URGING THE NATIVE HAWAIIAN CONVENTION TO CONVENE A WORKING GROUP TO DEVELOP RECOMMENDATIONS AND STRATEGIES TO CREATE HAWAIIAN NATIONALITY AS A PROTECTED CLASS FOR PURPOSES OF HAWAII'S ANTI-DISCRIMINATION LAWS." The purpose of the proposed resolution is to urge the Native Hawaiian Convention to convene a working group to develop recommendations and strategies to create Hawaiian nationality as a protected class for purposes of Hawaii's antidiscrimination laws.

The Committee may consider whether to recommend adoption of the proposed resolution, with or without revisions. The Committee may also consider the filing of County Communication 20-355 and other related action.
